NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS
The City of Hutchinson, Kansas, will hold two separate public hearings on September 15, 2026, in City Hall to present and discuss two proposed wastewater infrastructure projects. The City intends to submit two

separate loan applications through the Kansas Department of Health and Environment's (KDHE) State Revolving Loan Fund Program to fund the following:
5:30 p.m. - Public Hearing for Project #1: Water Resource Recovery Facility Reuse Project
This project will construct a reclaimed water system to beneficially reuse treated effluent from the City's Water Resource Recovery Facility (WRRF). Improvements include a new conveyance pipeline, lift stations, UV system modifications, an 8-inch force main, controlled outfall structure, and distribution infrastructure to deliver reclaimed water for irrigation of Carey Park, the golf course, public parks, athletic fields, and other approved uses. The project will conserve potable water supplies, reduce demand on the City's groundwater resources, improve water system efficiency during peak irrigation season, and provide a sustainable beneficial reuse of treated effluent.
Estimated Project Cost: \$7,200,000
Loan Request: \$7,200,000
5:45 p.m. - Public Hearing for Project #2: Sanitary Sewer Lining Project
This project will rehabilitate aging sanitary sewer mains through trenchless cured-in-place pipe (CIPP) lining in areas identified through system inspections. Work will include cleaning, CCTV inspection, CIPP lining, and localized point repairs to address structural defects and infiltration. These improvements will reduce inflow and infiltration (I/I), improve system reliability, extend the service life of existing infrastructure, reduce the risk of sanitary sewer overflows and backups, and support continued compliance with KDHE requirements.
Estimated Project Cost: \$2,000,000
Loan Request: \$2,000,000
The proposed improvements for both projects will

This project includes the rehabilitation of aging sanitary sewer mains through trenchless cured-in-place pipe (CIPP) lining in areas

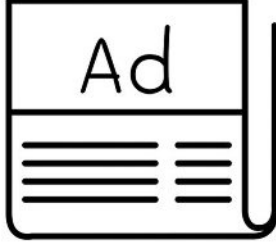

identified through system inspections. Proposed improvements include:
• Cleaning and CCTV inspection of existing sewer mains
• Trenchless CIPP lining of deteriorated gravity sewer mains
• Localized point repairs where needed to address structural deficiencies
• Rehabilitation of sewer segments exhibiting infiltration, joint separation, root intrusion, and other defects
These improvements are necessary to reduce inflow and infiltration (I/I), restore the structural integrity of the City's sanitary sewer system, improve system reliability, reduce the risk of sanitary sewer overflows and backups, and extend the service life of existing infrastructure while minimizing disruption to residents.
